# What Does Your Video Give Away?

## 2-Minute Whiteboard Activity: Spotting Safeguarding Clues in Everyday Content

Pupils aren't just watching content anymore, many are creating it. A single “get ready with me” or “day in the life” video can reveal far more than they realise: their school, their street, their daily routine. This activity gets pupils to spot it for themselves, in two minutes, with nothing to prepare.

### How to run it

- 1 Play a short “get ready with me” or “day in the life” clip to the class (or describe a typical one if you don't have a clip to hand).
- 2 Ask pupils to list everything visible in the background that reveals something about the person filming it.
- 3 Write their answers on the board under three headings: School identity, Location, Routine.
- 4 Ask the class: would a stranger be able to work any of this out just from what's on screen?

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**Quick tip for pupils:** Before you post, watch your video back and ask yourself, what could a stranger work out about me from this?
